Monday February 26 JEWISH LEGAL RIGHTS IN ISRAEL & JERUSALEM AREA

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- "Legal Grounds". Session at the hotel with ZOA Israel Office Director Jeff Daube: an in depth exploration of Jewish rights throughout the Land of Israel and in Jerusalem
- Join Keshet's Educational Director Daniel Ehrlich at the Haas Promenade for magnificent views of Jerusalem and to deepen understanding of the Jewish presence in and claim to Jerusalem, starting with the stories of Akedat Yitzhak & David's establishment of the city as capital of Israel.
- Lunch on your own
- Head out with Regavim to get beyond the myths and slogans related to land distribution, ownership and use by Bedouin tribes and other Arab groups in the Jerusalem and Maaleh Adumim areas. We will visit the E-1 area of Maaleh Adumim whose development has been blocked by international pressure and we will visit a Bedouin encampment and meet local Bedouin residents. Regavim is an organization whose goal is to ensure responsible, legal & accountable use of Israel's national lands

Tuesday February 27 ZOA: BRINGING THE JOY OF PURIM TO ISRAELI SOLDIERS

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- Join with the ZOA Brooklyn Region in distributing Mishloach Manot Purim Baskets to IDF soldiers
- Meet soldiers at a Mishmar HaGvul (Border Patrol) Base
- Evening and dinner on your own in Jerusalem

- Meet the people at **Milbat**, an innovative Israeli non for profit dedicated to increasing the level of independence, improving the quality of life, and facilitating integration into the community for disabled children, adults, and elderly via technology.
- Continue to the embattled city of Sederot which has endured years of bombardment by Palestinian rockets from Gaza.
- Help support the beleaguered shops of Sederot lunch and shopping time on your own
- Meet Sederot Mayor Alon Davidi and learn about the challenges facing the city.
- Join the **Yatar Elite Police Volunteer Counter Terror Unit** to tour the city and border areas and learn how residents cope with constant threats from Hamas controlled Gaza.
- Return to Jerusalem for evening and dinner on your own

Thursday March 1 THE ONGOING STRUGGLE FOR JERUSALEM (PURIM OUTSIDE OF JERUSALEM )

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Join **Ateret Kohanim** for a behind the scenes tour of the Old City of Jerusalem and the struggle to maintain and expand the Jewish presence.
- Lunch and shopping time on your own in the Old City
- Join ZOA Israel Office Director Jeff Daube a for a firsthand look at the struggle for Israeli sovereignty in and around Jerusalem on Jerusalem's northern "seamline" including visits to Givaat Hatachmoshet (Ammunition Hill) and Nebi Samuel
- Continue to **Mt. of Olives**. Learn about the leadership role ZOA plays in the USA and Israel to bring attention to the issue of grave desecration and how they brought about a significant decrease in Arab vandalism and violence.
- Meet residents of Maaleh HaZeitim who are building a flourishing Jewish community on Mt. of Olives in the face of unremitting Arab hostility.
- Optional Megillah reading on your own at one of Jerusalem's many synagogues

- Meet and distribute Mishloach Manot to IDF "Lone Soldiers"
- Festive Purim Lunch
- Return to the hotel to prepare for Shabbat (Shabbat candle lighting at 4:57 PM)
- Optional Kabbalat Shabbat Services on your own
- <u>Shabbat dinner</u> at the hotel

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- Enjoy the special atmosphere of Shabbat in Jerusalem by participating in Shabbat services at one of Jerusalem's many synagogues or take time to explore the city on your own
- Session at the hotel with Khaled Abu Toameh, Former Arab Affairs Correspondent for the Jerusalem Post
- <u>Shabbat lunch</u> at the hotel
- Early evening walking tour to the nearby famous **windmill** and the first neighbourhood built outside the Old City walls by **Sir Moses Montefiore** in the 1860s.

- Evening and dinner on your own in Jerusalem

Sunday March 4 SHOMRON - ROOTED IN THE LAND

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- Get a sense of Jewish roots going back thousands of years at Tel Shiloh which served as the home of the *mishkan* (Tabernacle) and spiritual center of the people of Israel over 3,000 years ago
- Visit a center for youth with special needs serving the communities of the Shomron
- Packed Lunch
- Head to the Three Seas Outlook at Itamar from where (on a clear day) you can see the Mediterranean,
  Kinneret and Dead Seas and 4,000 years of history from the days of Abraham till today.
- Learn about organic farming in the Shomron at Givot Olam near Itamar
- <u>Dinner</u> and wine tasting at the Turah Winery in Rechalim

Monday March 5 GUSH ETZION & HEVRON

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- At the ancient synagogue at **Susiya**, step back 1,500 years to the Talmudic era. *Learn about the history of this Jewish community and about the struggles that modern Susiya is facing*
- Head to Hebron learn about the challenges facing the residents of the Jewish community of Hebron who have re-established Jewish life in what was a thriving center of Jewish life until the massacre of the Jews by the Arabs 1929
- Visit the Me'arat Hamachpelah, the Tomb of the Patriarchs and Matriarchs
- Lunch
- Meet the organizers of Lev HaOlam, which supports local Jewish business owners in Judea and Samaria who are suffering because of the BDS movement in Israel.
- Visit and stand in solidarity with the **Ariel family** whose 13 year old daughter **Hallel** *hy*"*d* was brutally murdered in her bedroom by an Arab terrorist.
- Meet Women in Green founder Nadia Matar at the Gush Etzion Oz Vegaon Park established in memory of Gilad, Ayal & Naftali who were kidnapped and murdered just down the road by Arab terrorists.
- Return to Jerusalem for evening and dinner on your own

- Pack bus and check out of the hotel
- Head to the Knesset for meetings with Knesset members
- Lunch on your own
- Briefing and tour with **Col** (Res) **Danny Tirza, the IDF's chief architect** of the security fence/barrier. *Gain insight into the security issues involved with potential Israeli territorial concessions.*
- Summary session and **Farewell Dinner**
- One group bus drop off at Ben Gurion Airport and at the Dan Panorama Hotel in Jerusalem
