Matthew Tyrmand is the son of Polish-born Holocaust survivor, writer and anti-communist dissident, Leopold Tyrmand, who spent the war years 'in the eye of the storm', masquerading as a non-Jew primarily in Germany. Matthew Tyrmand's knowledge and interest in Poland, Europe and cultural attitudes towards Jews and Israel was inspired by his father's miraculous story. Matthew Tyrmand spent ten years on Wall Street as an equity trader, analyst and portfolio manager at NYC hedge funds before entering the world of politics, activism, and journalism full time. Mr. Tyrmand enjoys dual U.S. and Polish citizenship and is an outspoken Zionist. He advises the Polish government on an ad hoc basis and appears frequently in Polish print media and on Polish television, commenting on Polish, American, and European political issues. Mr. Tyrmand writes a weekly column for one of Poland's top conservative newsweeklies, *Do Rzeczy*, and has contributed to *Breitbart, Forbes*, and, *The Jerusalem Post* among others. He has also appeared on *Al Jazeera*.

Mr. Tyrmand holds a B.A. from the University of Chicago and is a Claremont Institute Lincoln Fellow.
