Tuesday June 13 Gush Etzion & Hevron Securing Jerusalem's Southern Flank

- Briefing and demonstration at Caliber 3 Counter Terror & Security Training Academy
- Meet Women in Green co-founder Nadia Matar at the Oz Vegaon Nature Reserve established in response to the murder of Jewish teens Eyal, Gil-ad and Naftali by Arab terrorists.
- Lunch with Jeremy Gimpel and Ari Abramowitz at Arugot Farm at the edge of the Judean Wilderness
- Head to Ma'arat Hamachpelah, the Tomb of the Patriarchs and Matriarchs in Hevron
- Meet Noam Arnon, spokesperson of the Hevron Jewish community and learn about the challenges facing the residents of the Jewish community of Hebron.
- Return to Jerusalem for a <u>Chef's Dinner</u> with Tastings of Israeli Wines
